- 1.Out of the four accounts of Jesus' life, John's gospel focuses the most on Jesus's divinity.
- 2. It does not contain parables like the other gospels, but rather lengthy discourses with I AM statements.
- 3. In John's gospel, Jesus turns water into wine and raises Lazarus from the dead.
- 4. In the feeding of the 5,000, the focus is on a little boy who shares his food with Jesus.
- 5. The Greek verb TOOK implies that it is not about the action of taking but what comes after.
- 6. Jesus takes the loaves and miraculously feeds the crowd, creating a sense of family and belonging.
