

Feast, Key Points

1. Out of the four accounts of Jesus' life, John's gospel focuses the most on Jesus's divinity.
2. It does not contain parables like the other gospels, but rather lengthy discourses with I AM statements.
3. In John's gospel, Jesus turns water into wine and raises Lazarus from the dead.
4. In the feeding of the 5,000, the focus is on a little boy who shares his food with Jesus.
5. The Greek verb TOOK implies that it is not about the action of taking but what comes after.
6. Jesus takes the loaves and miraculously feeds the crowd, creating a sense of family and belonging.
