- 1. People typically have the option to attend church or brunch on Sundays.
- 2. There are similarities between the brunch scene and church setting, such as food, fellowship, music, and shared values.
- 3. There is a difference between Sunday morning brunch and church: the main difference being Jesus Christ and worship as gathering around the WORD. But also, a difference is the way we practice gratitude in worship.
- 4. Expressing gratitude to God in the past was a response to specific gifts bestowed upon them and was known as the norm of reciprocity.
- 5. But this norm of reciprocity sets up God to be temperamental, which has turned many people off from the idea of God altogether.
- 6. Instead, scripture shows us that God's is not a targeted giver. But God's grace abounds.
- 7. The Greek word *Eucharist* means "Thanksgiving." The table of the Eucharist symbolizes God's love which is not earned or constructed, but rather lavished upon us.
